



MDSA Performance Company Cancellation Policy

As a family, you are the only ones who can decide at what level you can participate in respect to time, energy, and finances. We ask that you carefully consider all aspects of what you commit your child to participating in. Each Team member needs to put 100% into the team to be successful.

All financial matters are to be handled with the Office Manager. Please do not discuss financial matters with the instructors, staff members, or other parents. Should you have any financial issues, please speak with us so we are able to figure things out, an open line of communication is greatly appreciated! MDSA Foundation will do everything in our power to keep you informed and control costs as much as possible. Once you have made your commitment, please be advised there will be no refunds on apparel once it has been ordered.

If the season has not started in person yet, you may receive a refund minus the Cancellation Fee, which includes a \$25 fee for reworking the choreography and a \$25 administration fee. A lot of long hours go into creating a dance team that runs smoothly. Please understand this as you make your commitments.

In the event a contract is terminated, for any reason, once the season has started, the full balance of expenses is due at the time of termination. A \$50 non-participation fee PER ROUTINE will be assessed to your account and considered payable within two weeks of contract termination. When terminating your contract, this must be done through our studio [Withdrawal Form](#) found in-studio or on the [Pricing](#) page of the MDSA Foundation website. In addition to the termination fees, any dancer who has resigned once a contract is terminated is ineligible to audition for the next season's Company Teams.
